1. VKP Studio: 37 Rockbound Lane, Surry, (from Blue Hill take Rt 172 east towards Surry. In just under 7 miles take a sharp right onto Rt 176 and stay left onto Newbury Neck Rd. After 4.2 mi take a left onto Rockbound Lane. Studio is at the end of the lane.)

2. E&C Ceramics: 68 Popple Lane, East Blue Hill, (from Blue Hill take Rt 176 through East Blue Hill. Popple Lane is on the right 3 miles beyond East Blue Hill.)

3. Rackliffe Pottery: 132 Ellsworth Rd, Blue Hill, (from Blue Hill east on Rt 172, one mile on left.)

4. Mark Bell Pottery: Route 15, Blue Hill, (from Blue Hill, on right side of Rt 15, 1.5 miles south of Blue Hill center.)

5. Clay Forms Pottery: 189 Rope Ferry Rd, Sedgwick, (from Blue Hill take Rt 15 south for four miles to the stop sign. Go straight across onto Rope Ferry Road. One mile from intersection.)

6. David McBeth Studio: 186 Coastal Rd, Brooksville, (from Blue Hill, Rt 15 south for about 7 miles until Rt 175/176. Take a right towards Brooksville for 9/10 mile. Walker Pond Pottery Studio & Gallery is on the left just past the cemetery.)

7. Greene-Ziner Gallery: 73 Reach Rd, Deer Isle, (Left off Rt 15 onto Reach Rd, then 3/10 mile on right.)

8. Bunzy Sherman the Potter: 56 Pressey Village Rd, Deer Isle, (Rt 15A from Deer Isle Village, take right onto Pressey Village Rd.)

9. R-Place Studio: 32 Burnt Cove Rd, Stonington, (Follow Rt 15A from Deer Isle Village for approximately 4 miles. 32 Burnt Cove Rd is on the right just before Airport Rd and Burnt Cove Market.)

10. Mountainville Studios: 19 Winding Hill Rd, Deer Isle, (take left off Sunshine Rd before Nervous Nellie's.)

11. Barbro Chapman: 34 Chamberlin Dr, Deer Isle, (take left off Sunshine Rd just before the causeway.)

12. Brooklin Pottery Co-op: 24 Mountain Ash Rd, Brooklin, (take Rt 175 and turn onto Naskeag Rd. After 1/10 mile, turn right onto Mountain Ash Rd.)



GETTING TO BLUE HILL & DEER ISLE

Blue Hill and Deer Isle are located about 500 miles from New York City, 250 miles from Boston, 160 miles from Portland, Maine. Driving time from Portland is approx. 3-4 hours.

The most direct route from Southern Maine:

1. Take I-95 (Maine Turnpike) past Portland or I-295 (Coastal) through Portland.
2. Just past Augusta, take Exit 113 onto Route 3. Continue on Route 3 approx. 44 miles to Belfast.
3. Take left turn immediately after overpass; Route 3 joins with Route 1. Continue on Routes 1 & 3 about 17 miles to Bucksport.
4. After crossing the Penobscot River, bear right at traffic light joining Routes 1 & 3 with Route 15.
5. Go 4.3 miles until Route 15 diverges as a right turn from Routes 1 & 3. Follow Route 15 to Blue Hill and then, on to Deer Isle.
